Thank you for placing a request to post SUNY Press material on electronic reserve.

Provided the electronic rights are available for the material you seek to use, electronic reserve permission requests will be granted at the same rate as for photocopied course packets, which is .18 per page times the student enrollment number. Should an invoice be issued, the fee may not be reduced without prior consent of SUNY Press. If you prefer, please feel free to inform SUNY Press to withhold processing your request until you receive a final enrollment figure. Certainly, adjustments must be made based upon an increase in the enrollment figure post issuance of invoice.

**In addition to not allowing the material to be archived**, the following copyright notice and terms of use must be posted to your Web site:

"This site contains copyrighted materials, including but not limited to text, photos, and graphics. You may not use, copy, publish, upload, download, post to a bulletin board or otherwise transmit, distribute, or modify any contents of the site in any way, except that you may download one copy of such contents on any single computer for you own personal, non-commercial use, provided you do not alter or remove any copyright, author attribution, or other proprietary notices."

- Electronic posting is on a protected site whose content is password accessible **only to those students enrolled in your specified course**. Any alternative arrangements on your site must be explained to and approved by SUNY Press.

- The invoiced amount may not be reduced without prior written consent of SUNY Press.

- Proper adjustment will be made to the fee paid should the enrollment increase post issuance of invoice.
